Howe caverns is the largest show cave in the Northeast. The tour lasts about 80 minutes and shows the majority of the cave. Visitors begin at the elevators and continue to the end of the Lake of Venus, which marks the end of Howe Caverns' property. Beyond this point lie about 2,100 feet (640 m) of unconditioned and destroyed caverns which lead to the quarry and the natural entrance.
